

- Request Admin III asking council to provide funding for students who are unable to attend a field trip due to cost?
 - Motion from Karen for council to support the school with \$500 towards field trip expenses for families who are unable to financially participate; all in favour; motion approved
- Office referral tracking showed that the majority of office issues are a result of soccer and playground conflict; this resulted in a new PBIS matrix for the soccer and playground with the details determined by the staff and students
- PBIS apple draws are going good; admin acknowledges all kids who had received apples in the month with returning the apples to each class; kids are cheering for their classmates who have received; the nominating teacher of the winner receives a photocopy top up or an amazon purchase (\$10 value)

Budget update: Jenn D

- Council balance as of today \$8,070
- ASCE grant is still available for \$500. We need to come up with something we want to do. Has to benefit parents. Money needs to be spent by June. Ideas presented include a parent section for the library with different language books available; a parent night of 'how to' with my blue print, google classroom, etc.; dare to care bullying
 - All members will consider these and we will vote on how to proceed at the March meeting Jenn proposed no more fundraising for this school year. We can have minimal carry over and need to have a purpose in mind.
 - There was much discussion around the purpose. Terry is looking into a quote for having the furniture in the common area recovered. Terry/Kathryn will look into teacher wish lists and bring to council what is needed.

Other:

- What is the office referral tracking - Behaviour data tracking done through a program called Dossier; allows the admin team to track location, time, grade, days of incidents; shows the trends and where we can change/do things different (like the new PBIS soccer/playground matrix)
